With classes led by specialist tutors, you will be able to learn the basics or extend your skills, according to your experience. The weekend is based on re-creating the masque *Hymenaei*, with opportunities to dance, speak, sing and act, with music of the time led by Ruth and Colin Thompson. The masque text was written by Ben Jonson and the designs were by Inigo Jones, and the dance music is extant. It was first performed for the 1606 wedding of

Lady Frances Howard to Robert Devereux Earl of Essex. Sadly the marriage ended in divorce and scandal.

Programme

On Friday evening tutors will introduce the masque, discuss plans for its re-creation, and lead general dancing. Saturday morning classes are for beginners (with Ann Hinchliffe) or for more experienced dancers (with Anne Daye), learning steps and some more complex dances. In the afternoon and evening we shall re-create the masque: costume, dancing, music, song and spoken word. After a final rehearsal on Sunday morning, our version of *Hymenaei* will be performed.

Musicians or singers wishing to learn dances of the period are welcome; after discussions with tutors in advance, they may play for one of the classes, dance with us, or contribute to the creative sessions.

Dancers willing to take sung or spoken roles are very welcome. Please mention your experience or skills on the booking form.
